Public Comments; Ron Kirby from the Springwood Lake Assoc. informed us of their Labor Day yard sale. He also told us that the police have been patrolling more often and it is appreciated. Ron Rexer from the Farm Bureau Assoc. discussed the need for agricultural programs in the schools. Mr. and Mrs. Tenny spoke about township response from a burning complaint.

Don David-County Commissioners Report – Absent

Steve Stocking-Road Commission & Library – Steve commented that the Road Comm. appreciates the township brining project. Discussed gravel project between Athey at M-61 and Lilly Lake Rd. and the bridge project on Mostetler for 2010. Steve was asked about doing a speed study on Townline Lake Rd. He told us it has to be done by the State Police and there is no funding and it would be low priority. District Library takes over on January 1st.

Committee Reports: Road Commission Update – Committee is working well with the Road Commission. Second brining application is complete. Dave Cooper reports that blight continues to be a concern, however progress is being made.

Old Business; Discussed lake access rights and that the township should not get involved. Motion by Cooper and 2nd by LaBoda to hire Tracy Macon to fill the Assessor position. MC Motion by Wright to approve Fred Mathews as our new Liquor Inspector, 2nd by Duby MC
