**Guest: Don David, County Commissioner** gave an update on county business including that the the county will need to be 100% funded for MERS retirement in the future. David also informed that Equalization Director Kim Halas has accepted a postion in Gladwin County. Three candidates were on hand to share their qualifications, backgrounds, and answer questions. **Rick LaBoda** running for County Commissioner, **Pam Mayfield** running for County Clerk/Register of Deeds and **Tom Winarski** running for State Representative.

**Public Comments:** Marty Johnson reminded everyone of upcoming events including the Tri Athalon which will be taking place this coming Saturday. Athletes will be riding bikes on Townline Lake Road so extra caution should be observed. Maty also mentioned the opening of the Freedom Memorial Park and the Car and Motorcycle show in Clare.

**Committee Reports: Denise Goodenow, Planning Commission Chair** stated the commission met on May 5<sup>th</sup> and will meet again on June 14<sup>th</sup>. The commission has been discussing adding a plan for the park in the Master Plan and what the state laws cover for burning and littering.

**Mark Janeczko, Zoning & Blight Enforcement** reported he has issued 5 permits and has been busy with blight enforcement.

**New Business:** Cooper read the list of foreclosures from the county for the townships Right of Refussal. LaBoda moved to adopt a resolution that the township is not interested in purchasing any of the listed properties, supported by Iutzi, roll call vote, all in favor. MC
